Brixton Energy have funding available for;

- 1) projects and groups that engage residents of the Loughborough Estate and the immediate area in the subjects of; climate change, sustainability e.g. recycling or food growing, energy efficiency, fuel poverty.
- 2) for any community project that benefits residents of the Loughborough Estate and the immediate area.

You can apply for any amount between £50 and £750, which can go towards a one-off event or an ongoing project happening during 2022.

We will fund at least one project from each category. Depending on the number applications we receive and amounts requested we may fund more than one project. Funding can support core costs, project costs or capital costs. Funding can be for new or existing projects.

Timeline - please submit your expression of interest by February 28th 2022. We will then be shortlisting organisations and projects and asking for further information if needed. We are aware that many organisations are still experiencing disruption due to Covid-19. Who are Brixton Energy?

Brixton Energy is a renewable energy cooperative that own solar panels on the roofs of Elmore House and Styles Gardens on the Loughborough Estate.

The solar panels generate an income from selling electricity and a government subsidy called the Feedin-tariff. Some of this income is used to repay the cooperative members who invested in the installation of the solar panels, and the rest is contributed to a community fund.

The purpose of this fund is to support the local community in tackling climate change, increasing energy efficiently and fuel poverty and for general community activities..

What do you mean by Energy Efficiency, Fuel Poverty, Climate Change and Sustainability?

A project about **Energy Efficiency** might be helping people switch to LED lightbulbs or providing advice on how to control the heating in their home.

A project about **Fuel Poverty** could be helping people switch to cheaper energy suppliers.

A project about **Climate Change** could be about raising awareness of the problem and the solutions.

A project about **Sustainability** could be helping people grow food locally, creating space for wildlife or wasting less and recycling more.

What do you mean by "any community project that benefits residents of the Loughborough Estate and the immediate area?"

Your project could be providing food to those in need, activities for young people, helping people access services etc.
