About your role - Retrofit Assessor

This is an exciting opportunity for a community-minded Retrofit Assessor who cares about tackling energy-related issues locally and leading in work towards a more inclusive and sustainable future. We have multiple roles corresponding to the communities in which we are delivering this project.

As Retrofit Assessor, you will work alongside a diverse and supportive team to deliver the aims and objectives of this project. Your work will be locally based in Greenwich, Lewisham, Lambeth or Newham. You will work closely with a locally based Outreach Officer and Retrofit Coordinator to support households and residents through the retrofit process, primarily through delivering retrofit assessments for households in accordance with PAS 2035. You will participate in community engagement events to promote the concept and benefits of retrofit and explain the process for residents. You will be an excellent communicator and be able to work with a diverse range of stakeholders. You will be excited to be at the forefront of this project, and comfortable being crucial to the success of this project.

The Retrofit Assessor will carry out domestic Energy Assessments and supply data to the Retrofit Coordinator, within the PAS 2035 framework, and be part of an energy advice team. We are looking to recruit Retrofit Assessors to support Retrofit Coordinators in the delivery of a significant number of free retrofit option appraisals.

Your Role

- Carry out retrofit assessments in accordance with PAS 2035 protocols for energy efficient retrofit of domestic buildings.
- Provide advice on energy efficiency and renewable energy measures to householders, as part of the outreach team.
- Carry out measured surveys to establish dimensions of the dwelling's heat loss envelope.
- Identify constraints imposed by the site.
- Identify the installed building services.
- Carry out appraisal of occupancy special considerations and vulnerabilities.
- Produce relevant reporting to the Retrofit coordinator, using PAS Hub CoreLogic Retrofit software, and logging with ECMK Assessor Hub.
- Maintain accurate and records of interactions with clients, contribute to evaluation and research.
- Attend outreach events and provide Energy advice information to clients and at public events.

Skills

- Knowledge of the Retrofit process and the roles as identified within PAS 2035.
- Understand the retrofit industry and the processes involved.
- Knowledge of the Energy Company Obligation Scheme (ECO).
- Experience of energy assessment tools and models: SAP (full version), or PHPP software.
- Experience of carrying out accurate measured surveys of existing buildings
- Use of spreadsheets for data input and management and ability to check for errors.
- Understanding of building physics, including the thermal and moisture performance of different materials and construction.
- Understanding of building services including the different heating and ventilation systems available, how they operate and how they are controlled.
- Understanding of the whole house and fabric first approaches to domestic retrofit.
- Understanding and experience within the construction sector.
- Experience of customer-facing roles, in particular dealing with private households/owneroccupied clients.
- A strong communicator with the ability to tailor your approach to each individual.
- Risk awareness: you will be required to follow appropriate health and safety procedures as part
 of this work to protect you and the householders.
- Attention to detail: collecting and collating data accurately.
- Able to provide Feedback on the method and tools and issues raised by householders.

- Retrofit Assessor PAS 2035 qualification- or equivalent e.g.Level 4 Award in Domestic Retrofit Assessment (Retrofit Academy), Retrofit Assessor (Elmhurst energy)

- Accredited, ideally with ECMK and familiar with their core logic software/ Membership of a Trustmark Approved scheme.
- Academic or professional qualification in a built environment discipline, eg building surveying, architecture or architectural technology, engineering.
- Retrofit specific training or qualification e.g. AECB CarbonLite Retrofit, Retrofit Coordinator.
- Level 3 Award in Energy Efficiency for older or traditional buildings (PAS 2035).
- Conservation area property experience.
- Energy Efficiency in Older & Traditional Buildings (EEOTB) Level 3 Award.
- ECO funding experience.
- Knowledge of other energy assessment tools: PHPP, BREDEM, rdSAP.
