

We're solving the world's three big climate change problems



Net-zero is not working

We will currently miss our net-zero targets and are not keeping global warming to survivable levels.



Lack of investment

We need more fundable, self-sustaining, proven options for cutting the carbon emissions responsible for global temperature rises.



Inequality

Energy costs are increasing and the benefits of clean energy are not being shared with those who need them most. This stops people from changing their behaviour as required to reduce the consequences of higher global temperatures.

The great news is that clean energy holds the potential to tackle all three of these issues.

But only if it is deployed at scale, in the right way.



This requires a new kind of clean energy innovation with care for people at its core.





That's why we've created: **Repowered Community**

This clean energy model from **Repowering London** strengthens communities by delivering clean energy hand in hand with long-term local services and benefits. These range from skills training to lower energy bills and funds for local investment.

What we are:

A large-scale solar farm or wind project developer creating projects owned by a limited number of stakeholders who will take a profit.

Boosted by our own low-cost finance option and commitment to using the best technology to suit the task – whether a solar energy install or energyefficient retrofit.




Green skills

By providing lower-cost energy, creating warmer and healthier homes and less pollution we can end fuel poverty and reduce urban health deficits.



A Repowered Community in practice: Roupell Park

In 2013, **Repowering London** supported residents to install solar power across a number of social housing blocks in Brixton, South London.

The electricity powered lifts and lights, and profits from its sale supported local initiatives chosen by residents through a ring-fenced community fund. For instance, providing free meals to families during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Local young people were trained in community development and installed the solar panels. They also learned to install energy-saving measures across the estate.

Since 2021, residents have been able to buy the solar power generated on the Roupell Park roofs at **17% of market rate - saving people 25%** on their annual energy bills.

Over just 10 years, our team has established **10 community-energy co-ops across London,** working closely with local councils and supporting the Mayor of London's net-zero targets.

Investment innovation

We've pioneered a **fasttrack funding vehicle to move projects quickly** and offer a proven model for building fundable, selfsustaining social enterprises.

Ending inequality

Our community-led approach **cuts energy costs for those who are most vulnerable**, reducing inequality and supporting positive behaviour change.

Community Benefit Societies & co-operatives supported
